

Camp Rules

St Mary Gillingham Scouts

We all hate rules, but they are necessary so that we all have common expectations and equal opportunities to have fun and join in.

Our most important rule is to carry out the Scout / Cub Scout Promise.

Mobile Phones

- Contact with parents will be made via the InTouch, a leader can help you with this.
- Members are not to have mobile phones on camp.

Behaviour

- Good behaviour is expected at all time.
- Older Scouts are expected to act as role models for younger members
- You will adhere to the Scout Law and promise.
- The **Scout Camp Leader** reserves the right to send any participants home if deemed necessary.
- We operate a yellow and red card system. A red card will result in you going home. We will reward good behaviour.
- You will be expected to undertake chores while on camp. e.g. collecting water, fire wood, washing up, tidying up. etc.
- You are expected to attend the daily briefs (flagpole) and follow any instructions given promptly so that all member can remain safe and get to their activities on time.
- You are responsible for your own belongings.

Uniform

- You should bring full uniform on camp. You are expected to turn up in uniform.

Packing

- You will pack your own bags and use the packing list as guidance. If you are short of an important item please let us know in advance. Do not struggle on without it.

Where can I go?

- You will be advised at the start of the camp bounds, you will not be allowed outside of these bounds without permission from the **Scout Camp Leader**.
- There will be certain areas you will not be allowed in e.g. the kitchen, store, chopping circle unless invited.

What if I don't want to do an activity?

- You will not be forced into doing any activity you do not want to do, you are free to sit out, but must not disrupt the activity. There are usually alternative activities to do, let us know as soon as you can.

Medicines and Money

- Medicines and pocket money will be prepared in accordance with the packing list and handed to a leader on the first day.

Food, Snacks Sweets.

- Any food items you bring with you must be kept in the central stores and are not allowed in the sleeping tents, this is to maintain hygiene.

Unwell or need to talk

- Please let a leader know if you feel unwell or just want to chat things over.
